The monthly meeting convened at 7:30 PN in the Commissioners' room at Station #2. Those in attendance were Commissioner Kevin Bowman, Commissioner Marty Schanz, Commissioner Andrew Casucci, Commissioner Grant Keeler, Treasurer Carl Visconti, Secretary Karan Donohue, Administrator Tim Brousseau, Administrative Assistant Lisa Castaldo, Chief Tim Kimball, 1st Assistant Chief Michael Stanley, 2nd Assistant Chief Tim Brousseau, Lt. Don Andrews, and President Phil Brousseau. Commissioner Dave Pettis was absent. However, he was in phone contact.

Bills

Commissioner Casucci made a motion to pay the bills. Commissioner Schanz seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.

Old Business

Commissioner Schanz made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 11, 2026 meeting. Commissioner Casucci seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.

Treasurer's Report

1. Bank statements, account reconciliations, and check images for May 2026, and the listing of transactions approved and paid in May 2026 were given to Commissioner Casucci for verification.

1. Commissioner Schanz made a motion to purchase the following:
 - a. One (1) Scott 4.5 60-minute cylinder from Dival for \$1,786.69 (State contract number PC69018)Commissioner Casucci seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.
2. Commissioner Schanz made a motion to approve the following:
 - a. ETA-621, ETA-625, ER-631, and M-635 to West Crescent on June 15 & 17
 - b. ER-631, TA-626, and the pickups for the fourth of July parade in Clifton Park.
3. ETA-625 is at VRS to have a new pump installed.
4. There was discussion on outfitting the new trailer.
5. Due to a shortage of used cars, we may need to purchase cars for an extrication drill.
6. There will be an ISO audit in August or September.
7. Attorney Hannigan is okay with the draft for the bailout system.

Administrator's Report

1. Station #2 doors hard mechanism is worn and won't release all the time.
2. Discussion on who is eligible to use the workout room. Spouses of members and social members will be allowed to use the room with their spouse and social members with another member.

1. There will be a meeting with the insurance company on Wednesday to discuss the replacement motor on ETA-625. We will be paying for the belts and washers to be replaced.
2. Commissioner Schanz made a motion to have to top cover on ER-631 redone by xxxx. The cost will be between \$500-700. Commissioner Casucci seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.
3. The UTV will be serviced by Power Sports in Broadalbin
4. M-625 (I forgot it's number) was serviced. VRS will start on the apparatus.
5. Jim Davis will be mowing the lawn at Stations #2 and #3.
